The applicants-petitioners seek review of our order dated  
18.03.2021:-

*“When confronted with the fact that the Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for and is permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the respondent-authorities by filing a representation.*

*Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana fairly concedes that in case the petitioners does so, the respondent-authorities shall look into the same and if necessary also grant hearing to the petitioners and thereafter take a decision on the representations expeditiously as early as possible.*

*In view of the statement/undertaking given by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the petition stands disposed of.”*

For the applicants alleged to have moved a representation, in terms of our order referred to above, which is pending consideration before the respondent-authorities, there is hardly any occasion least a sufficient ground to seek review. The order under review does not suffer from any error apparent on the face of record. Thus, the application is accordingly dismissed.

However, if any such representation is pending before the respondent-authorities, we are sanguine that the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law.
