Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.36, dated 14.03.2021, having been registered at Police Station City South, Moga, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (with Section 29 of the NDPS Act having been added later on).

Pursuant to the order dated 23.04.2021, learned State counsel submits, on instructions from ASI Jitender Singh, that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any

stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
