Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.117 dated 21.03.2020, registered under Section(s) 25/54/59 of the Arms Act and Section 379-A (charge-sheeted under Section 379-B IPC), at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered on the complaint of one Shyam, on 21.03.2020, he alongwith his cousin was going to a village and when they were coming back, three young boys came from front side and snatched his motorcycle on pistol point.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the petitioner was arrested in this case, he was nominated in two other FIR Nos.180 dated 26.04.2020 and 181 dated 27.04.2020 which were registered lateron and in both these FIRs he has been granted bail by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner was

arrested in this case on 21.07.2020 and since then he is in custody.

Learned State counsel could not dispute the factual position. It is also not disputed that the petitioner in two subsequent FIRs has been released on bail by this Court.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, without commenting upon the merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case especially that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year and 01 month; the investigation is complete and the conclusion of trial will take sometime, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate concerned.
