This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 25.5.2020/1.6.2020 (Annexure P-5), passed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samalkha, whereby issuance of Arms Licence has not recommended. Further prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the representation dated 2.2.2021 (Annexure -7) for re-consideration of the application for grant of arms licence to the petitioner as the petitioner is being facing threat perception from anti-social elements.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on the representation of the petitioner dated 2.2.2021 (Annexure P-7) within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of

the respondents. Counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 2.2.2021 (Annexure P-7) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
