Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No.16 dated 24.03.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran in FIR No.57 dated 13.03.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 29.04.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and both the parties have suffered

injuries. It is further submitted that it will be a matter of trial as to which was the aggressor party...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.04.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
