Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent authorities to release the Honorarium along with arrears and interest @ 12% per annum to the petitioners.

Instead of pressing the petition on merits, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that his clients would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 01.03.2021 (P-6) is decided by the competent authority on some early date.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide legal notice dated 01.03.2021 (P-6) of the petitioners within a

period of 8 (eight) weeks from today by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.

Needless to say that in case, claim of the petitioners is found to be genuine, benefits be released to them forthwith.
