1. This order shall dispose off the aforesaid six petitions filed on behalf of Ramji, Jog Raj @ Joga Ram, Mohinder Kaur, Bimla Rani @ Bimla Devi, Ram Sarup and Madan Lal respectively, seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.104 dated 14.10.2020 at Police Station Sadar, Phagwara, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323/324/341/506/326/149/148/325 IPC.
2. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, all the petitioners have since joined investigation and that their custodial interrogation is not required. It has further been informed that it is a case of cross-version wherein the offences under Sections 324/325/326 IPC in the instant FIR in which the petitioners are seeking bail, had been deleted after inquiring into the matter. It has also been informed that in fact even in the cross-version, offence under Section 325 IPC stands deleted.
3. Having regard to the fact that it is a case of cross-version, wherein more serious offences punishable under Section 325 and 326 IPC have already been deleted and while also noticing that the petitioners are stated to have joined investigation and are not

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required for any custodial interrogation, all the petitions are accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court in each of the case are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
