This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside of order dated 16.03.2021 passed by the Additional Civil Judge Sr. Division, Firozpur Jhirka, District Nuh, whereby the application of the petitioner for release of the vehicle was ordered to be dismissed.

A bare perusal of the impugned order shows that the earlier order was passed by the trial court on the agreement arrived between the parties qua payment of some money by the specified date. However, the petitioner has not even followed his own undertaking qua making the said payment by the said specified date. Therefore, the trial court has rightly dismissed the application filed by the petitioner. Otherwise also, this court does not find any illegality or irregularity with the order passed by the trial court.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
