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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondent No. 3 not to harass the petitioner and his wife by raiding their house and by calling them at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga time and again.

It is stated that on 27.1.2017, 3 unidentified persons committed murder of one Kuldeep Singh alias Keepa at village Bhutter Kalan. On the statement of complainant/informant Amandeep Singh, FIR No. 7 dated 27.1.2017 under Sections 302, 34 IPC was registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga. Sometime in the month of January 2021, police officials of Police Station Badhni Kalan visited the house of petitioner and informed him that his son namely Gagandeep Singh is required in connection with investigation of a case. Petitioner and his wife were directed to produce their son at Police Station Badhni Kalan. Petitioner and his wife informed said police officials that their son Gagandeep Singh is not living with them. They have no contact with their son since May 2017 and that they are not aware about his whereabouts. Despite that, police of Police Station Badhni Kalan are repeatedly raiding the house of petitioner and threatening the petitioner and his wife to produce their son before the police.

Without commenting anything on the merits of case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 that in case, petitioner and his wife are required in connection with any investigation or inquiry, proper procedure as contemplated in the Code of Criminal Procedure be followed.
