Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.450 dated 29.07.2020 under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 307,
325 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was
passed by this Court on 23.07.2021: -

“...Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. As per the FIR the assailants were with muffled faces and it was impossible for injured-Pardeep to have named the petitioner in his statement under Section 161 of the Cr.P.C. as he did not know the petitioner personally. Even otherwise, no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner and the single injury which was declared to be dangerous to life and attracting Section 307 of the IPC is attributed to co-accused Aman. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation and motorcycle already stands recovered from the co-accused.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dayanand, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, he was asked to hand over the weapon of offence and thereafter, he left the police station and is still required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.07.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to issue a notice in writing to the petitioner directing him to join the investigation.
