After arguing for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to grant any relief, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition. Since the petitioner intends to surrender before Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana and move an application for regular bail.

He has submitted that keeping in view the facts that the petitioner does not have any past criminal record and he is a middle aged person especially in this time of corona, his application for regular bail be ordered to be decided expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is observed that on petitioner surrendering before Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana within 7 days from today, his application for regular bail be decided expeditiously.
