Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he apprehends threats to his life at the hands of private respondents, who are his immediate family members.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to misdeeds of private respondents, the petitioner disinherited them from all the moveable and immoveable properties vide affidavit dated 06.07.2020 (Annexures P-1 and P-2). However, thereafter he was threatened with dire consequences by the private respondents. Learned counsel further submits that vide representation dated 18.03.2021 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) he had also approached authorities concerned, however, nothing has been done in the said regard till date. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider and decide his representation dated 18.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 18.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) and take necessary action, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
