The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 15.03.2021 registered under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS act and Section 61 of the Excise Act at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Notice of motion was issued on 23.04.2021 and said order shall form part of this order as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 23.04.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

This fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jaskaran Singh and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required as he has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
