Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.14 dated 29.01.2021 for the offences under Sections 307, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar Commissionerate, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that on account of previous enmity between the parties, the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case in hand by the complainant and attributed sword blow on the head of the injured Happy. He further submits that in fact the petitioner was not even present at the spot at the time of alleged occurrence, which finds support from the CCTV Cameras installed in the vicinity of the house of the petitioner.

Heard.

A perusal of the contents of the FIR in question reveals that the petitioner, who has been specifically named in the FIR along with two other co-acused, came to the spot armed with lethal weapons i.e. swords and daggers and thereafter inflicted as many as 13 incised injuries on various parts

of the body of the injured Happy including six injuries on the head. All the 13 injuries received by the complainant were opined to be dangerous to his life. It also needs to be noticed that the injured was medico-legally examined soon after the occurrence and the ocular testimony finds corroboration with the medical evidence.

In the wake of the allegations levelled against the petitioner and role attributed to him, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
