This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0023 dated 23.02.2021 under Sections 353, 186, 332, 333, 224 and 511 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR registered at the statement of ASI Kaushal Chander, it is stated that he is serving as the Investigating Officer in Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur and when an information was received in the Police Station that a boy has been arrested in connection with theft in the house of one Dharampal, he along with ASI Balbir Singh in a private vehicle reached at the house of Dharampal and the boy was produced before him. Thereafter, FIR No.22 dated 23.02.2021 under Sections 454 and 380 of the IPC was registered against accused namely Balkar in Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur. It is also stated that when the accused was taken in a vehicle driven by ASI Balbir Singh, the complainant was sitting at the back side of the vehicle and Balkar was handcuffed and then he suddenly opened the

window of the vehicle and tried to jump. The complainant caught hold of his leg and the vehicle was stopped. When the accused tried to escape, both the police officials nabbed him and in that process he started having a scuffle with the police officers to get himself free and run away. In that process, the accused gave a bite on the right ear of the complainant and the lower part of the ear was chopped off.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The interim order dated 28.04.2021 granting concession of interim bail to the petitioner stands dismissed.
