The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.252 dated 16.11.2020 registered
under Sections 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 326 and 201 IPC added
later on) at Police Station Kartarpur, district Jalandhar.

Briefly stated, the case of the prosecution is that on 14.11.2020
the petitioner along with his co-accused gave beatings to the complainant
and his father which included a *Kirpan* blow by the petitioner on the left
side of the head of the complainant.

On 16.08.2021 this Court had passed the following order : -

“Case taken up through Video Conferencing.

*Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia
contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in
this case; after lodging of the FIR the petitioner was*

arrested and released on bail which concession he has not misused; after addition of Section 326 IPC the petitioner is again sought to be arrested but the grievous injury is not attributed to him; the only injury attributed to the petitioner has been declared simple and that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr. J. S. Ghumman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 08.11.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.252, dated 16.11.2020, registered under Sections 324, 326, 201, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency; the investigation is complete; the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 16.08.2021 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
