By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 58 having been registered at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal, on 15.03.2021, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Section 18 (c) and 21 (b) of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 22.04.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
