Petitioner- Lajpat Rai Singh has filed the present writ petition seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent no 1- Registrar General (Vigilance) to take action against respondent no 2-a sitting Judicial Magistrate 1st Class for alleged misconduct.

Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner at length and perused the record.

It is apparent that the petitioner has raised certain factual disputes regarding the alleged mis-conduct on the part of respondent no 2 with allegations regarding extra-marital affair of his wife with said Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. It is averred in this petition that a representation dated

25.01.2021 (P-4) was made to respondent no.1 to order immediate probe/inquiry into the matter.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for respondent no.1 states that representation Annexure P-4 has been considered and filed by this Hon'ble High Court.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the Petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with permission to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
