The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.99, dated 18th March, 2010, registered under Sections 20, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali

2. The Petitioner was earlier granted bail by the Ld. Trial Court, since it was a case of recovery of a small quantity of *Ganja*. He however absented from the proceedings and was declared a Proclaimed Offender.

3. It has been submitted on his behalf that actually the Petitioner was addicted to taking drugs, on account of which, his in-laws got him admitted into a De-addiction Centre in Delhi from where he was not allowed to come outside for a long time.

4. Considering the aforesaid circumstances and the overall

background of the case and also the fact that following his re-arrest the Petitioner has by now remained in fresh detention for 6½ months since 4th November, 2020, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
