Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner had purchased a property vide sale deed dated 12.09.1980 (Annexure P-1) from one Sh. Gurdial Singh son of Sri Bishan Singh, the mutation of which has been sought for by the petitioner for which an application was moved on 04.01.2021 before the competent authority i.e. Tehsildar, Ludhiana Tehsil, Ludhiana-respondent No. 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though, no order has been passed by the said authority so far on the said application rejecting the same but the prayer of the petitioner for entering the mutation keeping in view the sale deed dated 12.09.1980 has not been accepted so far by respondent No. 3 and that too without any valid

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as nothing was being done to grant the prayer of the petitioner as requested vide application dated 04.01.2021, the petitioner served upon the respondents a legal notice dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration with the authorities and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the claim of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Sunint Kaur, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has also joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel submits that the respondents have no objection in deciding legal notice dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondent is directed to decide the legal notice dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
