The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 138 dated 25.09.2019 under Sections 279, 337, 338 IPC and Sections 307, 302 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation with interim relief.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact has not been denied by the learned State counsel. However, learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant,

opposed the prayer on the ground that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 279, 337, 338 IPC, but thereafter, the offence under Section 307 IPC was added vide DDR No.45 dated 25.10.2019 and after the demise of the then injured William, the offence under Section 302 IPC has been added.

In view of the allegations made in the FIR, the specific allegations have been made that the driver of the offending car ran over with high speed on the injured and, thereafter, he again ran over the car by reversing the same, thereby, causing serious injuries on the person of William. Both legs of the injured were fractured besides receiving grievous injuries on the other parts of the body.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations, petitioner is not entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail.

This petition is accordingly dismissed.
