The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0027 dated 28.03.2021, registered under Section 379 read with Section 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

The operative part of the order dated 02.09.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 02.09.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 02.09.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
