This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.144 dated 15.11.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148 & 149, Indian Penal Code, 1860 & 25/27/54/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur. The petitioner apprehended her arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 27.04.2021, whereby, while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel contends that in the alleged

occurrence, Lal Singh and Boota Singh were injured and the injury suffered by Lal Singh has been attributed to the petitioner, which is simple in nature. In this regard, learned counsel has invited the attention of the Court to the MLR dated 14.11.2020, which is part of the police proceedings.

Notice of motion for 16.08.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted herself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Shamsheer Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.04.2021 is made absolute.
