Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.59 dated 07.03.2021, under Sections 379-B, 324, 506, 323, 341 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that an altercation took place between the accused and the complainant. The petitioner is stated to have given a 'kappa' blow on the hand of the complainant. The injury was found to be simple in nature. It is also alleged that the motorcycle of the complainant was taken away by the petitioner and other accused. He, however, contends that the petitioner is physically challenged and has 52% permanent physical impairment due to post poliomyelitis residual paralysis L. He has referred to the copy of the certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Jalalabad, at Annexure P2.

This Court, by the order dated 29.04.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 29.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
