Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not in contact with the present petitioner namely Sandeep Saini and, therefore, he cannot ascertain whether the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.35,000/- or not in terms of the order dated 15.07.2020 vide which, he was released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.1 submits that the said amount has not been paid despite number of opportunities granted to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel-respondent No.2 submits that on 30.10.2020, it was noticed that if the petitioner does not pay the said amount within one month from the date of the order, this revision petition will be deemed to be dismissed without any further reference to the Court.

Even on 04.12.2020, again time was granted to the petitioner to deposit the said amount of Rs.35,000/-.

In view of the same, this revision petition is dismissed.
