This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to conduct a fair, proper and speedy investigation in representation dated 20.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that at the instance of private respondents, a formal FIR under Section 498-A IPC, etc. already stands registered against both the petitioners, but the particulars of the same are not presently available with him.

The above stand of the learned counsel makes it clear that the private respondents have adopted a remedy in law by lodging their complaint with the police, whereupon cognizance has been taken, therefore, it cannot be said that the apprehension of threat expressed by the petitioners is founded on convincing grounds.

Resultantly, no ground is made out for exercising of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
