The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.32 dated 15.04.2015 under Section 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are that 03 buffaloes were allegedly stolen. The petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail but he could not appear in the trial Court on 03.01.2019 as the petitioner was involved in another case wherein he has now been acquitted. He also contends that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on each and every date and he shall not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 27.04.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate and he was to be released on ad-interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sangrur on 05.05.2021. A copy of the order dated 05.05.2021 is taken on record.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having submitted his bail bonds, the order dated 27.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
