The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 26.11.2020 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.1 of not including the petitioner in the management committee, managing the house of Shaheed Sukhdev; on behalf of the family of Shaheed Sukhdev.

A bare perusal of the petition shows that the petitioner does not have any legal right to seek the relief which he has sought in the present petition. Furthermore, the order/communication dated 26.11.2020 (Annexure P-8), which has been impugned in this petition, does not even deny what the petitioner is trying to claim. The said order/communication has only asked the petitioner to produce some valid

documents to prove him to be the legal descendant of Shaheed Sukhdev.
Hence, there is nothing which can be adjudicated upon by this Court even
qua the said order/communication.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the petition, the
same is dismissed.
