In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled for regularization of his service w.e.f. 31.01.1996 instead of 24.07.1999.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the employees who were junior to the petitioner, their services were regularized from the year 1996 whereas, the benefit of regularization of his service was only given w.e.f. 24.07.1999, which is arbitrarily and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance by filing a representation dated 16.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) before the District Education Officer, Palwal, which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 16.09.2020 by passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and raises no objection with regard to prayer of the petitioner for deciding the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 16.09.2020 in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being raised by the petitioner in the present petition as well as in the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 16.09.2020, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation submitted by the petitioner Annexure P-6 dated 16.09.2020 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
