Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.127 dated 17.06.2020, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is alleged to have given knife blow on the injured. The petitioner is 19 years of age and is in custody for over 11 months since his arrest on 17.06.2020. The injured has fully recovered from the injury.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh upon instructions from SI Puran Singh states that the petitioner is also involved in another case and in view of the serious allegations against the petitioner, he is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner, who is 19 years old, is in custody for over 11 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the

conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the Police Station, Sector-31, Chandigarh on every alternate Monday till the conclusion of the trial. He shall also furnish his mobile number to the SHO of the concerned police station and keep the location of his phone on.
