This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has approached this Court seeking a mandamus directing the respondent-authorities to issue in his favour a Regular Letter of Allotment of a residential plot under the oustee quota in Pinjore Kalka Urban Complex.

Pleaded case is that land of the petitioner was acquired in the year 2009. Petitioner was vested with a right for consideration and allotment of the plot under the oustee quota under the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy of the year 2010. Heavy reliance is placed by counsel upon memo dated 17.10.2014 (Annexure P-4) issued by the Estate Officer, Panchkula in favour of the petitioner and whereby the Screening Committee has found the petitioner eligible for allotment of a residential plot admeasuring 3 marlas.

The memo in question is in the nature of a 'certificate of entitlement'.

Precise grievance set forth is that the formal letter of allotment has not yet been issued.

Counsel at the very outset makes a submission that he would be satisfied if the writ petition were to be disposed of with a direction to the concerned authority to examine the claim of the petitioner.

We find the submission advanced to be just and reasonable.

In view of the averments made and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the second respondent i.e. the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran, Sector 6, Panchkula to examine the grievance/claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 15.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) that is stated to have already been served, in accordance with law and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of.
