The prayer in the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the revised pensionary benefits after notional promotion to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner along with some other colleagues had approached this Court by filing CWP No.3851 of 2013 titled “Surinder Kumar &Ors. Vs. State of Punjab”. Thereafter, the petitioners therein were given notional promotions from back date. He would further contend that while the other petitioners, who had filed CWP No.3851 of 2013 have been paid the revised pensionary benefits after notional promotion, the petitioner has not been extended the same benefit. He further states that in this regard a demand/legal notice dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) has been sent to the respondents, however no action/decision has been taken on the same. Hefurther states that, at this

stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 and 3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Abhaypal Singh Gill, AAG Punjab has put in appearance through video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take a decision on the demand/legal notice dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law, expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
