AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No. 335 dated 29th October, 2020, under Sections 323, 325, 506 read with 34 IPC (Section 307 added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

The FIR was result of dispute between two brothers. In the incident alleged in the FIR, complainant had sustained injuries including one on the head, later on, Section 307 IPC was added.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 1st January, 2021. The brothers have bridged their differences and have compromised the matter.

Mr. Devender Arya, Advocate appearing for respondent No.2 supports the factum of compromise.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner is involved in number of cases.

It is a case involving Section 307 IPC where head injury was given. The dispute was between two brothers. In the heat of a moment the things went out of hand. The matter has been compromised. Petitioner is in custody since 1st January, 2021. Investigation in the present case is complete and no recovery is to be made. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take time. Petitioner is granted bail on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
