The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.348 dated 11.09.2020, under Sections 409, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the co-accused, who was the Secretary of the Cooperative Bank, had embezzled the funds and a part of it was deposited in the account of Sakir son of Naklu. Petitioner Sakir is son of Lallu @ Latlu, resident of village Dondal, Tehsil Punhana, District Nuh while Sakir son of Naklu is resident of village Gokalpur, Tehsil Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh. The alleged account No.003634001100137 is in the name of Sakir son of Naklu. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana wherein it is stated that the father's name of the petitioner was erroneously mentioned as Naklu although

account No.003634001100137 is in the name of the petitioner and he had been operating the same. A sum of ₹36 lacs had been transferred in this account by co-accused who was the Secretary of the Cooperative Society and had embezzled the fund.

In view of the serious allegations against the petitioner especially when ₹36 lacs of the embezzled fund had been deposited in the account which he was allegedly operating, I do not find any merit in this petition which stands dismissed.
