Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to re-check the paper of petitioner for appointment to the post of Social Studies Master.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, instead of pressing the instant petition on merits, states that at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 13.01.2021 (P-5) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, A.A.G., Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the

innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 13.01.2021 (P-5), in accordance with law by passing speaking order expeditiously, but not later than 20.08.2021.
