Through this writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order demanding licence fee for the years 2019-20.

At the very outset, it was pointed out to the learned counsel for the petitioner that the order is appealable.

Counsel for the petitioner has very fairly stated that actually there are four other cases. He had filed appeal in those cases but despite long period of time, no decision has been taken thereon. The petitioner is ready to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file an appeal in this case also but direction be issued to the Appellate Authority to consider the prayer for interim relief and to decide the appeal within a reasonable time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has very fairly accepted the abovesaid suggestion.

In these circumstances, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal before the Appellate Authority, who shall decide the prayer for interim relief within a period of three weeks on the presentation of the present appeal and will decide this appeal and the other similar appeals within further period of three months thereafter in accordance with law.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
