This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.91 dated 10.4.2019, under Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Allegations are that Satnam Singh @ Soni (deceased) was murdered by the petitioner. At his instance mobile of Satnam Singh was recovered. Petitioner was seen coming out of the house and entering in his house and his clothes were blood stained.

The main ground for seeking bail is the custody period.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are twenty-four witnesses, fourteen witnesses have been examined, crucial witnesses are yet to be examined and next date fixed before trial Court is 14.12.2021. Submission is that earnest efforts would be made to conclude the prosecution evidence within four months from the next date fixed.

Mr. Mohit Sadana, Advocate, appears for complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made by learned State counsel, he is not pressing the present petition at this stage.

Disposed of.

No doubt, in case a request is made before the trial Court for accommodating dates for an early conclusion of prosecution evidence, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
