Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.206 dated 25.12.2020 under Section 21-A of NDPS Act and Section 29 of NDPS Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 29.04.2021: -

“...Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner has been nominated in the said FIR on the disclosure of co-accused, who has in fact been nominated by another co-accused. He would further submit that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

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Mr. Bhupinder Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice for the respondent-State and as per the instructions received from the IO, submits that no other case is pending against the petitioner...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.04.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
