Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.60 dated 25.03.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. He further contends that petitioner No.1 had also received an injury for which DDR under Section 326 IPC was registered.

This Court, by the order dated 30.07.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarmanjit Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 30.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
