The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.25 dated 02.04.2021 registered under Sections 18 and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion was issued on 28.04.2021 and said order shall form part of this order as well.

As per allegations, the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused namely Meeta Singh. 300 grams of opium was recovered from the aforesaid Meeta Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 28.04.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

This fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Pushpinder Kaur and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required as he has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 28.04.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
