The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.141 dated 10.12.2018, registered under Sections 21, 22, 61 & 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short – the NDPS Act) at Police Station City-1 Mansa, District Mansa.

The petitioner is being prosecuted for having been found in illegal possession of 50 vials of Onerex (100 ml), 9600 tablets of Alprasafe, 500 tablets of Tramadol and 1000 tablets of Carisoprodol.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that in the petitioner's trial 09 out of 10 prosecution witnesses already stand examined and therefore, at this stage, the petitioner be not granted regular bail especially when he faces another case under the NDPS Act.

At the fag end of the petitioner's trial, this Court does not consider it desirable to grant regular bail to the petitioner especially in the

light of heavy recovery of psychotropic substances from him as also because he faces another case under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above the present petition is dismissed with a direction to the Trial Court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within two months from the date next fixed before it, in accordance with law.
