This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondent No.2, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of official respondents No.3 and 4, who are unnecessarily harassing the petitioners under the influence of private respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the private respondents herein have duped the petitioners herein of the life savings of the father who had died while in service. The private respondents have also withdrawn the cash whereas they are not entitled to do so. The petitioners herein are the only legal heirs of deceased Baldev Raj. It is now submitted that a civil suit has been filed against the respondents for illegal withdrawal of money and service benefits of the father of petitioner No.1. However, they are being harassed by the private

respondents through the official respondent No.3 and 4. They have already moved a representation dated 29.03.2021 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2, in this regard, however no action is taken thereon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider and decide the representation dated 29.03.2021 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously.

Notice to the State of Punjab.

Mr. Bhupinder Beniwal, A.A.G., Punjab appearing through the medium of video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the request of the counsel for the petitioner, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider and decide the representation dated 29.03.2021 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a reasonable time.
