1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226 of Constitution of India read with Section 3 sub-clause (1) sub clause (a) of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Amendment Act 2015 for seeking grant of emergency parole for permitting the petitioner (who is a convict in case FIR No. 122 dated 24.10.2014 under Sections 302/307/148 and 149 of IPC Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar) to attend the Bhog ceremony of his deceased mother on 24.4.2021 i.e. tomorrow at 1:00 pm under police custody.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that keeping in view the fact that it would not be possible for this Court to verify the averments made in the petition, in this connection, the petitioner has also moved a representation to the respondent No.2 (Annexure P-1) which had been e-mailed on 21.4.2021 and at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 – Jail Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana

to decide the same by 10:00 am tomorrow.

3. We find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to decide the same by 10:00 am tomorrow in case copy is supplied to him today.

4. Petition stands disposed of with above-said directions.

5. Copy be handed over to the learned counsel under the signature of Bench Secretary.

5. Since the main petition has been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
