The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.67 dated 02.04.2021, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of an agreement to sell between the petitioners and the complainant. The allegations are that the petitioners had mortgaged the property and not informed the complainant about the same while entering into an agreement to sell. The matter was sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and it has been settled.

This Court, by order dated 16.09.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Joginder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 16.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
