This second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for pre-arrest bail has been filed by the petitioner Prabh Dayal, aged about 30 years, resident of Guru Ravidas Nagar, Ward No.14, Malout, Tehsil Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, an accused in FIR No.0316 dated 27.11.2020, under Sections 324, 323 and later on added Section 326 IPC, registered with Police Station City, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, his first petition having been dismissed vide order dated 7.1.2021.

It is stated that on account of change in circumstance, the instant petition is being filed.

Hon'ble Apex Court in a recent judgment **G.R. Ananda**

Babu Versus The State of Tamil Nadu & Anr. has observed that the specious reason of change in circumstances cannot be invoked for successive anticipatory bail applications, once it is rejected by a speaking order and that too by the same Judge.

Therefore, the present petition is not maintainable and stands dismissed accordingly.
