The present criminal writ petition by virtue of Article 226 of

life and personal liberty of the petitioners as well as their properties.

Be so as it may, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to look into the representation dated 05.04.2021 (Anneuxre P-4) moved to SSP, Hoshiarpur by the petitioners, fully in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and in the meanwhile, to ensure due protection of life and personal liberty and properties of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
