The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.22 dated 07.02.2020, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the son of the petitioner and the complainant. With the intervention of the mediator, the matter has been compromised.

This Court, by the order dated 10.06.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
