Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the orders dated 27.02.2021 (Annexures P-3 & P-4), whereby the petitioners have been compulsory retired from the post of Head Constables.

At the outset counsel has submitted that appeals against the said order have been filed with respondent No.3 and he does not wish to press the present petition on merits and would be satisfied if the said appeals are decided within a time-bound frame.
