Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 163 having been registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police District Batala, on 01.08.2019, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 457/380 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbir Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 29.04.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, she would be always at liberty to avail of her remedy as per law.
