Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.25, dated 28.3.2021, having been registered at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS, Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been arraigned by the police on a disclosure statement allegedly made by his co-accused who again allegedly, was apprehended at the spot with 2500 intoxicant tablets, with it also stated in the FIR that (it was not denied that they were recovered in the presence of a gazetted officer).

Notice of motion.

Mr.S.S.Deol, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice at the asking

of the court.

Upon query to him, he submits that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner and consequently there would be no reason for the petitioner to be falsely implicated with the police did not even know him.

Upon query to learned counsel for the petitioner as to whether he can show any enmity with any police official or even with his co-accused, Paramjit Singh, who is stated to have been caught at the spot with 2500 intoxicant tablets, he expresses ignorance on the subject.

That being so, without making any comment on the merits of the case, I see no reason to entertain this petition which is consequently dismissed.
